**ADMISSION NOTICE BHMS 2016-2017**

Applications are invited for Admission to Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (BHMS) 5½ years Course 2016-2017 at Nehru Homoeopathic Medical College, New Delhi. The Bulletin of Information may be obtained from the office of the Joint Registrar, Faculty of Homoeopathic Medicines, 6<sup>th</sup> floor, V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi -110007.

- (i) **By Hand against a crossed M.I.C.R. Demand Draft only drawn on any Nationalized Bank in favour of the 'Registrar, University of Delhi' payable at Delhi for ₹ 750/- (₹ Seven Hundred & Fifty Only) for General/OBC Categories & ₹ 550/- (₹ Five Hundred & Fifty Only) for SC/ST/PWD Categories between 09:30 A.M. to 03:00 P.M. from 18.10.2016 (Tuesday) to 04.11.2016 (Friday) on all working days (Monday to Friday).**
- (ii) Application Form may also be downloaded from websites [www.du.ac.in](http://www.du.ac.in), [www.fmhc.ac.in](http://www.fmhc.ac.in) & [www.nhmc.delhigovt.nic.in](http://www.nhmc.delhigovt.nic.in) and submit the same, duly filled in and complete in all respects with requisite Demand Draft, to the office of the Joint Registrar, Faculty of Homoeopathic Medicine, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi- 110007 **on or before 04/11/2016.**
- (iii) The Application Form can also be obtained, by hand against Demand Draft from the office of the Principal, Nehru Homoeopathic Medical College, B -Block, Defence Colony, New Delhi.

**Note:-** SC/ST/PwD Candidates are requested to bring/ send a copy of the self attested Caste Certificate/ PwD Certificate for obtaining Bulletin of Information.

**1. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

**(A) Age:** He/She must have attained or will attain the age of Seventeen (17) years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016.

- (i) **For 85% Delhi Quota Seats :** The candidates seeking admission to 1<sup>st</sup> Prof. BHMS course must have passed Intermediate/Senior School Certificate Examination (CBSE)/Indian School Certificate Examination (12 years course) or any other equivalent Examination recognized by the University of Delhi for admission to Undergraduate courses with 50% or more marks in the aggregate of **three subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and has also passed English as one of the subject** from a recognized school conducting regular classes situated within the National Capital Territory of Delhi (except Patrachar Vidyalaya and Open School) (40% Marks in case of SC/ST/OBC category candidates). **While deciding the merit the marks obtained in English will not be taken into consideration.**

**In respect of candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs, the minimum of 45% for Gen-PwD and 40% Marks for SC-PwD/ST-PwD/OBC-PwD are required.**

- (ii) **For 15% All India Quota Seats (except Delhi quota) :** The candidates from all over India who have passed the prescribed qualifying examination from an Indian University/Board (12 years course) from a recognized school conducting regular classes or any other equivalent Examination recognized by the University of Delhi for admission to Undergraduate courses with 50% or more marks in the aggregate of three subjects i.e. **Physics, Chemistry, Biology and has also passed English as one of the subject** (except Patrachar Vidyalaya and Open School) (40% Marks in case of SC/ST/OBC category candidates). **While deciding the merit the marks obtained in English will not be taken into consideration.**

**In respect of candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs, the minimum of 45% for Gen-PwD and 40% Marks for SC-PwD/ST-PwD/OBC-PwD are required.**

- (a) The candidates for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> Prof. BHMS course shall be selected strictly on the basis of merit.
- (b) The admission to BHMS course shall close on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2016.

**Note:** The eligibility conditions for admission to BHMS course may be revised in the light of the notification of CCH/Ministry of AYUSH, GOI/ University.
